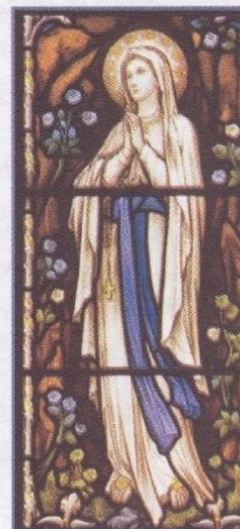

Pastor's Column

To the Parishioners of Our Lady of Lourdes & St. Michael:

In his letter to the people of the diocese, published in the Tennessee Register of July 4, 2014 Bishop Choby announced that to mark the 100th Anniversary of the Cathedral of the Incarnation in Nashville, he is commissioning a new altar for the cathedral and that he has "given each parish a goal based upon the size and ordinary income of the parish."

After last weekend's Masses, several people asked me what our assessment is for the additional altar at the Cathedral. The bishop said he is "leaving it to your

pastor's discretion to reach this goal either by a contribution out of the parish's ordinary income or by a special collection for this purpose." Since this assessment is not a part of our respective budgets, I will be having a special collection on the weekend of July 19 and 20 for this project. I now will quote (in part) from the Bishop's letter to me regarding this collection.

"It is my hope and desire that all of the parishes in the diocese will participate in creating this

significant memorial for the Cathedral's anniversary. From a practical point of view it helps to pay for the altar, but for me, it is much more than that. The project tangibly and visibly expresses the unity that the gift of faith effects. As you know so well, the Eucharist is at the heart of this gift. I very much wish you to communicate this message to your parishioners and have them involved personally in this project through their prayers and financial support.

"I have established a goal for each parish based upon your proportional ability to give. The goal for" Our Lady of Lourdes is \$2, 853.00 and for St. Michael is \$825.00.

On July 26th the diocese will ordain nine men to the Priesthood of Jesus Christ. It is a milestone for the diocese and we should all be deeply thankful to God for Him to offer us fine, young men, several of whom I know from my years of working as Vice-Chancellor of the Diocese. May those still in seminary, including seminarians who have served us in the past: Leo, Andy, William and Mark from Totus Tuus, and now, our current seminarian Rick, be strengthened in their faith and in their calling and may we continue to pray for them and for our diocese.

ACQUIRING HOLY HABITS

Watch a baby learning to walk, a child attempting to ride his new bike or a teen climbing behind the wheel of a car for the first time and you will immediately remember that the process for learning something new is not smooth. There are falls, tumbles and jerky stops, but persistence is rewarded - the toddler learns to run, the bike ride to race and the teen driver masters the art of merging onto a freeway.

Developing habits to foster a virtuous life requires the same kind of persistence and the reward - eternal life in heaven - is infinitely more desirable than anything else we may seek to learn.

As Archbishop Fulton Sheen points out, "every habit either helps a man attain his eternal end, which is God, or else it impedes

and confuses by forging a chain which is difficult to break."

The first place to start on acquiring the habit of holiness is prayer. Here are a few simple suggestions to start the process.

Every morning, when your feet hit the floor beside your bed, begin the day with a prayer of thanks and seek guidance for the day.

Say grace before every meal, even if the meal is a stop at the takeout window of a fast-food restaurant.

Set aside at least 20 minutes of each day to say a Rosary. And when that seems impossible break it up into five-minute decades.

End the day with a review of your successes and failures and a prayer to try again with God's Grace.
